Overview[.]

Abraham entrusts his lead servant to return to his family's country to find a wife for Isaac. Both Abraham and the servant entrusted God to lead the way.

Things to consider:

- Abraham was adamant about following God's instruction (to remain in the Land of Canaan).
- Abraham's lead servant was adamant about following GOD's instruction praying to the LORD God of Abraham.

Bible Study:

Read Genesis 24. Consider how God has demonstrated to be a God of "steadfast love and faithfulness" (verses 27 and 49) in your life.

The story of Isaac's marriage is another example of God's sovereignty and faithfulness. His promise to make a nation of Abraham that would be blessed to be a blessing to the entire world, was going to move forward through Isaac and Rebekah's family. God orchestrated the circumstances to bring Isaac and Rebekah together in the land of Canaan that would become the land of Israel, and eventually give rise to the Savior, Jesus.
