Scriptural Basis:



Exodus 2:11-25: 3

Overview:

Moses grows up as a member of Pharoahs household, but loses his position when he kills an Egyptian who is beating on an Israelite. He is forced to flee Egypt, and ends up in Median, where he meets his future wife. After spending years in Midian, God calls Moses back to Egypt to

Things to consider:

Being born an Israelite, Moses started out his life as a fugitive. He then became a fugitive again while defending an Israelite. He then was told by God to return as a fugitive to lead his people out of bondage.

Bible Study for Preparation:

Read Exodus 2:11-3-22. Consider how God once again selects an unlikely candidate – a man wanted for murderer – to carry out His purposes.
