

Premise: God looks at the heart.

This craft is to emphasize that offerings made to God are ultimately about the heart of the offeror, not what is being offered.

All of the offerings in this craft LOOK fine on the surface, but the underlying hearts are very different.

Instructions:


1) Color hearts that are submitted to Jesus in bright colors (yellow, orange, red), and dark un-submitted hearts in dark colors (brown, black (but still legible)). There are two submitted and two un-submitted hearts.

2) Cut out the different food offerings (which are meant to LOOK equally appealing, so be sure to emphasize there is NO difference between meat and vegetable offering))


3) Place one over each heart, by taping the top edge of the graphic above a heart (so that it can be flipped up to reveal the heart). Be sure to place a vegetable offering over one of the submitted hearts, and a meat offering over the other.

4) Discuss what is different about the underlying hearts.
